Students may read a chapter book of their choice that is on or above reading level of Lexile 450 which is equivalent to an AR level of 2.5.

The following chapter books are just some examples that would fall into these reading levels to give you an idea.

Amelia Bedelia, American Girl, Boxcar Children, Magic Tree House, Fly Guy, and Hardy Boys.

It is very important for students to continue to read over the summer break. Students are also asked to read at least 10 books and track them on the attached Reading Log. The Reading Log should be turned in with their Story Sequencing Book Report. These books can be picture books, but should be on an AR level of 2.0 or higher.


Sequencing Book Report
